

##### **Directions:**

Take I-64 west across the Sherman Minton Bridge to New Albany. Take the first exit and turn right onto Scribner Drive. Take Scribner Drive to the end and turn right on main street. Go three blocks and look for Daisy's on the right at W 5<sup>th</sup> street. Parking on the side.

After lunch we will go south on hwy 111 to Mauckport Indiana crossing the river and stopping in Brandenburg for gas. Then continue to Muldraugh Kentucky stopping at the Dairy Queen before heading home.






