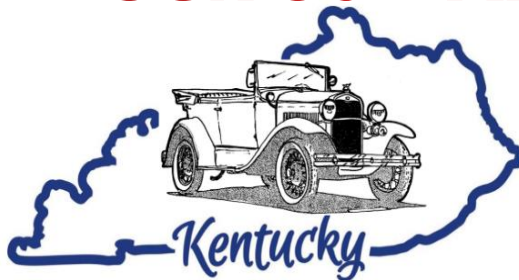

On Friday the 11th of October 2019, **Charlie Armstrong, Moise Napier, Fred Shelton, Louis Nett,** and **Jim Norris**, and I had planned to go to the Threshermans Park in Boonville IN to meet the Owensboro Model A Ford Club members and see The Moron Brothers Show. They were to be there from 7:00 to 9:00 PM CST. It would be at least 10:00 PM EST before we could get away from there. The weather forecast was rain moving in about 7:00 or 8:00 PM Friday night which it did. We felt like it would not be wise to drive Model A's the 133 miles after dark in the rain taking a chance of a break down in the middle of the night. So, we canceled that tour. But **Moise Napier** wanted to go somewhere. He called me up and said that he would like to check out the Kenny's Farmhouse Cheese in Austin Ky. 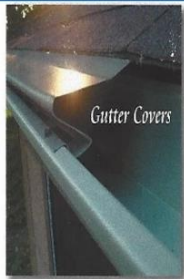
