
Our club now has (21) vehicles registered in the MARC Mileage Awards Program.

If you are not in the MARC Driving Awards Program and would like to be please contact **Roy Armstrong.** To participate: your Model A must be registered in the program by the owner; a registration fee of \$1 paid; a must be a member of MARC.

Your odometer reading must be reported to your MARC Regional Chairman immediately after December 31st of each year. A radiator plaque is awarded at the completion of 2,000 miles, and a replacement mileage tab is awarded at 5,000 miles and at each 5,000 miles thereafter.


