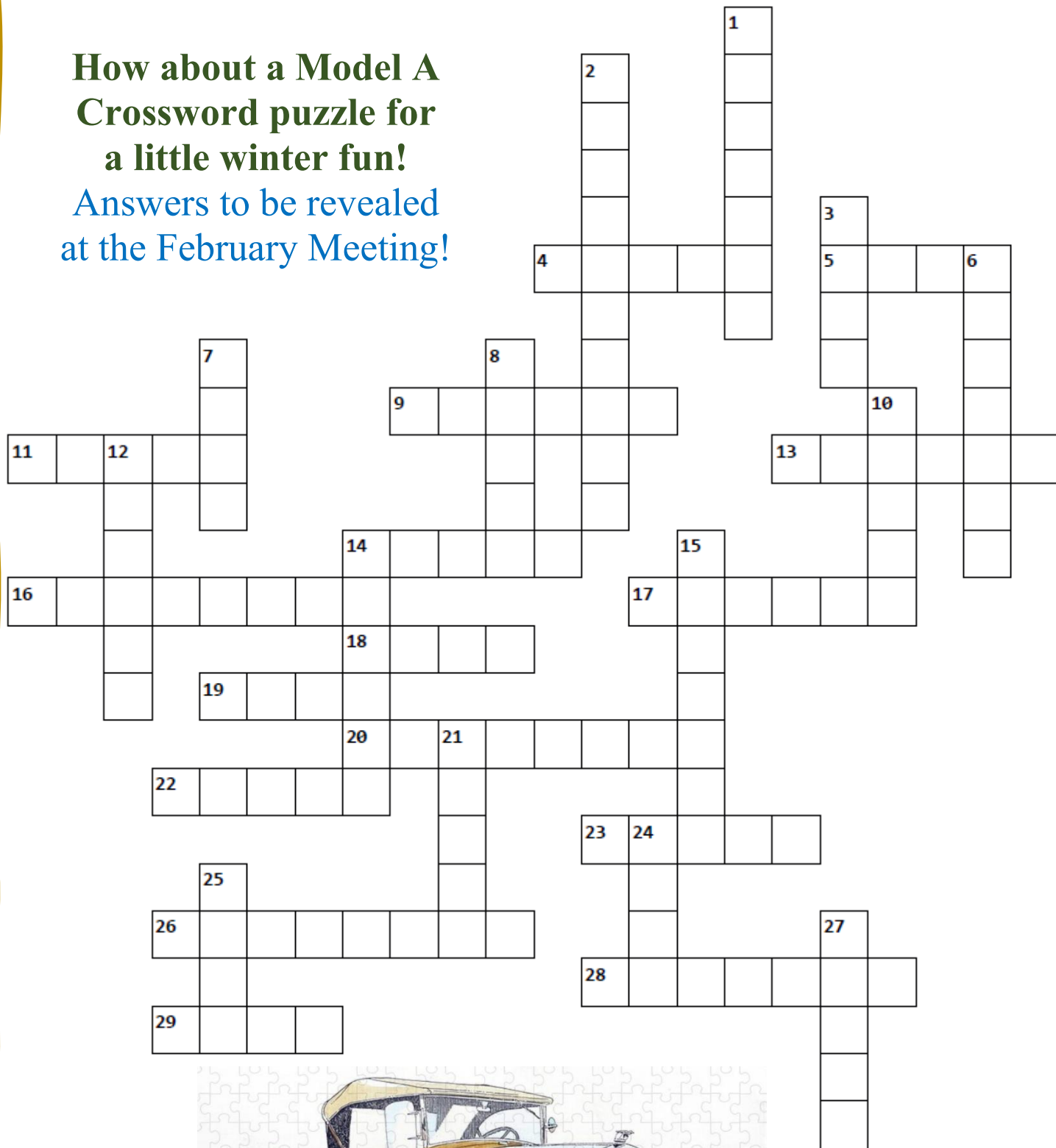

- 4. — The "Station ____" was a body style featuring wood paneling.
- 5. — The shape of the famous Ford logo badge.
- 9. — The pedal on the left (used to change gears).
- 11. — The exterior shade located just above the windshield.
- 13. — The name for the four-door sedan body style.
- 14. — Hand lever located on the steering column (controls ignition timing).
- 16. — A stylish "leatherback" body variant introduced later in production.
- 17. — The colloquial name for the folding seat in the rear trunk area.
- 18. — The number of cylinders in the Model A engine.
- 19. — The type of wheel spokes that became standard (replacing wood).
- 20. — Hand lever located on the steering column (controls speed).
- 22. — The horsepower rating of the Model A engine (double that of the Model T).
- 23. — Henry Ford's son who championed the Model A's improved styling.
- 26. — An open-top body style with no side windows.
- 28. — An open body style with two rows of seats and four doors.
- 29. — The color of the oval radiator emblem, which became standard with this model.

- 1. — The Model A used a conventional ____ gear transmission (3-speed).
- 2. — The type of braking system used on all four wheels (rod-actuated).
- 3. — The device that made the distinctive "ahooga" sound.
- 6. — The Model A's styling was often compared to this luxury Ford brand ("The Baby ____").
- 7. — The company that produced the Model A.
- 8. — The most popular body style (two-door sedan).
- 10. — The pedal on the right.
- 12. — Hydraulic components added to improve ride comfort.
- 14. — The Model A was the first car to feature this type of shatterproof glass in the windshield.
- 15. — Curved metal bars added to the front and rear for crash protection.
- 21. — The massive river factory complex where the Model A was manufactured.
- 24. — The interior panel housing the gauges and instruments.
- 25. — The location of the gas tank (situated between the engine and the dashboard).
- 27. — A closed two-door car, often preferred by business travelers.
